- 301 **A pair of Chinese blue and white teabowls and saucers**, Kangxi, each decorated with phoenix and flowers; together with a **Chinese export famille rose teabowl and saucer**; an **Imari pattern bowl**, 23cms diameter; and a **Lowestoft 'two bird' pattern teabowl and saucer**. (5)

- 302 **A Chinese Wucai-style ginger jar converted to a lamp**, the jar decorated with a dragon, phoenix and cloud scrolls, with brass and wooden mounts, fitted for electricity with fabric shade, the jar approximately 20cms, the lamp 50cms overall.

- 316 **A pair of Chinese famille vert 'pillows'**, each well decorated with geese, birds, growing flowers and rockwork, within iron-red Ruyi head borders, pierced cash medallion ends, 17cms. (2)

- 317 **A Chinese famille rose vase**, 19th/20th Century, decorated with a continuous scene of scholars in a garden, double Buddhist lion handles, chilong at the shoulders, 29.5cms.

- 318 **A Chinese Jun ware bowl** in Yuan style, with thick glaze falling short of the foot rim, with purple inclusions through a graduated grey-blue ground, 15cms diameter; and **a pear-shaped stoneware vase**, with Tenmoku style glaze, impressed mark, 16.5cms. (2)

- 319 **A Chinese famille noir biscuit porcelain vase**, Qing, moulded in high relief with scholars below a writhing dragon on a black-glazed ground, impressed Kangxi seal mark to base, paper label for the Gulbenkian Museum Durham, numbered LJ 10, 21.5cms.

- 320 **A Chinese famille rose two-panel low screen**, Qing, with two rectangular porcelain panels painted with a corpulent figure and five boys in a landscape, the other with immortals at sea, each 25cms x 38cms, within a two-fold hardwood hinged mount, 63 x 66cms overall.

- 321 **A Nanking Cargo Batavian ware teabowl and saucer**, circa 1752, decorated in underglaze-blue with peony and bamboo growing from rockwork, Christie's paper label lot 5245; and **a Chinese blue and white bottle vase** decorated in underglaze-blue with figures in a landscape with pagodas, Ruyi head border, four-character Kangxi mark in blue, 24cms.
