One-piece prototype ski suit used for fitting purposes on Pierce Brosnan for The World is Not Enough 1999, the suit was made as a development sample for fitting and refining the final garment worn by Brosnan in the film, the ski suit was manufactured by Omega Outdoor LTD, based locally in Amble, Northumberland.

Provenance: The story began with a costume scout from the film production crew walking into an Outdoor store we suppled in Chester, asking if they knew how to get a 'bespoke' ski suit made. The manager of this store put them in contact with Alan and I, director and designer of Omega Outdoor, based in Amble Northumberland. Eon Films costume department for this Bond movie was in a mobile office based in the costume suppliers 'Angles' in London, where Alan and I met with Lindy Hemming, this her 3rd Bond Movie as Costume designer. Ski not being her speciality, the design would be created by us, Brosnan's preferences and likes discussed, cinematographers requirements included in the brief. Then it was down to my design experience in Skiwear to create.

In late 1998 we began work on Pierce Brosnan's costume and a further 5 for the ski scene stunt men all different sizes to Brosnan, and for the special effects dept, after exchanging what can only be described as Origami' mock-ups with the special effects team of how we would execute what they needed. The scene in the movie where Brosnan is caught in an avalanche, required an airbag to be blown out through the rear of the suit, we created Velcro panels where the airbag was inserted and subsequently would inflate. The Movie working title while we were working on this, was bond 19 'Elektra' which later turned out to be the leading female characters name Elektra King.

The Suit for auction was used to make the final adjustments in a fitting session with Pierce Brosnan, a fitting I was due to attend before a twist of fate, huge snowfall in the Chamonix area which was the films location, a serious avalanche in Montroc in the Chamonix area, lead to the postponement of filming, Brosnan delaying his travel to Europe from the US. The suit was Designed and manufactured in Amble, Northumberland by Omega Outdoor in Feb 1999, the final suit supplied days before filming took place.

The final suit bore no Branding at all, a stipulation of Eon, but on the final days of filming we were asked to produce a Jacket version of the suit with exploding panels to be worn by John Cleese in the Q lab sequence, they needed it in super quick time, we had to supply this jacket with our Omega Outdoor branded lining, noone expecting this to be visible in the movie, but in the sequence the grey with silver Omega branding can be clearly seen, (to one who knows).
